

FIREFIGHTER

The City of Columbia Civil Service Board will conduct examinations for the position of Firefighter. Beginning salary starting at \$9.32 per hour. Requirements: High school degree or GED, must be 18 years of age, have a valid Class D Drivers License, and must possess and maintain current Emergency Medical Technician license with the State of Tennessee in order to be accepted to participate in the testing process. Applicants must furnish a copy of birth certificate, high school diploma or GED certificate, and EMT certification with their application before review by the Civil Service Board. Extra points will be given to applicants who show proof of current certifications in Firefighter Levels I and II through the Tennessee Commission on Firefighting, International Fire Service Accreditation Congress or National Board on Fire Service Qualifications. Physical examination and drug screening will be required prior to employment. Civil Service Testing: Successful completion of an ability test will be required to qualify applicants to take the written civil service examination. Civil Service Examination date and time will be announced to qualified applicants by letter after closing date. As there is now no residency requirement for this position, applicants are not required to live within the boundaries of Maury County after employment.
