

**A RESOLUTION TO APPLY TO THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION,
FY 2011 TIGER III DISCRETIONARY GRANT PROGRAM
FOR FUNDING OF THE BOULEVARD PROJECT TO SUPPORT CONSTRUCTION
OF ROADWAY, PEDESTRIAN, AND SCENIC IMPROVEMENTS TO
SR-50/JAMES CAMPBELL BOULEVARD**

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia, Tennessee is eligible for funds under the United States Department of Transportation TIGER III Discretionary Grant Program; and


WHEREAS, the need exists to make improvements to the existing SR-50/James Campbell Boulevard to create a multi-way boulevard that supports walkability, healthy neighborhoods, and the economic competitiveness of the community; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia wishes to submit an application for said project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA as follows:


- (1) The Mayor of Columbia is hereby authorized and directed to execute and submit an application for the FY 2011 TIGER III Discretionary Grant Program.
- (2) The Mayor of Columbia is hereby authorized and directed to enter into all necessary agreements to receive and administer such grant funds.
- (3) The total estimated cost of the project is \$10,000,000. The City of Columbia is eligible for up to \$10,000,000, or 100 percent of the total project cost, from the United States Department of Transportation TIGER III Grant Program.
