

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND TITLE 9, CHAPTER 7, SECTION 9-705
PERTAINING TO THE TERM AND RENEWAL OF YARD SALE PERMITS BY
DELETING THE EXISTING SECTION 9-705 IN ITS ENTIRETY AND REPLACING
SUCH SECTION WITH A NEW SECTION 9-705.**

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, as follows:

Title 9, Chapter 7, Section 9-705 of the Columbia Municipal Code, pertaining to term and renewal of yard sale permits be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

9-705 Term and renewal of permits:

Yard sale permits shall be effective for a period not to exceed two (2) consecutive days and such effective dates shall be stated on the permit. Only two (2) yard sale permits shall be allowed at the same location within a calendar year.

This amendment shall become effective January 1, 2007.

**AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT AND REGULATE
YARD SALES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Title 5, the city of Columbia licenses, permits and regulates businesses, professions and occupations within the corporate limits of the City; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of said City to permit and regulate yard sales within such corporate city limits:

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF COLUMBIA:

Section 1. That Title 5, be amended by adding an additional Chapter 11, regarding the Regulating and Permitting of Yard Sales which states as follows:

9-1101: Permitting of Yard Sales. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation, partnership, association or any other organization to conduct a yard sale in the City of Columbia without first obtaining from the City of Columbia a permit to conduct said yard sale.

9-1102: Application Requirements. Applicants for a permit under this chapter must file with the City Recorder a sworn written application containing the following:

- (1) The names and addresses of the persons, firms, corporations, partnerships, associations or other organizations wishing to conduct said sale.
- (2) The exact location where the yard sale is to occur.
- (3) The time and dates for such sale.
- (4) A basic description of the types of products to be sold.

9-1103: Fee. At the time of filing the application a fee of Five Dollars (\$5.00) shall be paid to the City to cover the cost of issuing such permit.

9-1104: Use of Streets. No Permittee shall have any exclusive right to any location in the public streets nor shall

any be permitted a stationary location thereon nor shall any be permitted to operate in a congested area where such operation might impede or inconvenience the public use of such streets. For the purpose of this chapter, the judgment of a police officer, exercised in good faith, shall be deemed conclusive as to whether the area is congested and the public impeded or inconvenienced.

9-1105: Term and Renewal of Permits. Yard Sale Permits shall be effective for a period of two (2) days and such effective dates shall be stated on the permit. Any individual Permittee shall be limited to two (2) Yard Sale Permits within a twelve (12) month period.

Section 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict are hereby repealed.
